**Solar Eclipse Glasses** Out of an abundance of caution for student and staff safety, during the solar eclipse on April 8th the Public Schools Branch will be dismissing 2 hours early on Monday, April 8, 2024. <u>Students will follow their regular end of day plans unless parents reach out with alternate plans.</u>

The Department of Education and Early Years has acquired ISO 12312.2 certified solar eclipse glasses (filters for direct observation of the sun) for all students, prioritizing safety for this upcoming event.

Glasses will be distributed to students closer to the event. To enhance safety awareness, we'll be providing students with valuable lessons on eclipse viewing precautions. Parents, stay tuned for more information to ensure a well-prepared experience for all.
