Improving Student Attendance will be one of our goals this year. Most children miss a few days of school each year without long-term consequences. However, when students miss too many days, the effects are almost always negative. We are continually working to make our school environment a place where everyone is safe, healthy, and ready to learn. What can you do to help?

- Build regular routines for bedtime and the morning,
- Set out clothes pack backpacks, and lunches the night before,
- If there is a reason that they aren't looking forward to school regularly, please reach out and let us know so we can address it,
- Schedule trips when school is not in session when possible.
- Schedule medical appointments after dismissal if possible

Breakfast Program is up and running on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays each week. Thank you for our wonderful volunteers!!

**Food Program** Our Hotlunches Program is up and running for the year. All orders and payments must be in by 9 am on Mondays. Please Note: If there is NO school on Fridays we will have pizza day on Wednesdays.

The PEI Food School Program is up and running. Families can register at and spoon with your child each day. Cutlery is not provided with lunches.

Terry Fox Run will take place on Friday, September 27th. Students are encouraged to bring in a donation for our Walk on Friday (weather permitting). Students will have the opportunity to learn about Terry Fox throughout the week.

This year we are focused on building a bigger and stronger connection between our families along with supporting various school activities throughout the year. <u>Water Bottles</u>: Please ensure your child comes to school everyday with a water bottle. We DO NOT have extra water bottles at the school.

<u>Safety Issues</u>: <u>Confederation Street</u> - Concern has been expressed in the past over student safety. We ask for your cooperation in dropping off and picking up students on the school side of Confederation Street only. <u>Please do not drive into the staff parking lot to drop off students.</u>

Parents dropping their children off in the morning, please remember that supervision begins at 8:15 am and the bell rings at 8:25 am for school to start. Students can be dropped in the back pavement area and our greeters will welcome them. Parents are asked to say goodbyes at the doors. <u>Pick up time is 2:30 pm and there is no additional supervision after the busses leave.</u>

**School entry**: The back door will remain locked during the day. All visitors must enter through the

main door if you need to come to the school. We ask you to please ring the doorbell on the right hand side and wait until a staff member greets you. Visitors are asked to sign in at the table at the top of the stairs.

**Student Sign Out:** If you are picking your child up early from school after you have been greeted by a staff member we ask you to please come up to the top of the stairs and sign your child out.

<u>Dismissal</u>: Parents picking their children up at the end of the day can meet them outside the front door. Students are dismissed at 2:30 pm. Students **SHOULD NOT** be by themselves crossing the road to get into parent/guardian vehicles.

<u>Lunch/Recess Times</u>: This year our lunch recess will be 11:25-11:50 am and the students eat lunch from 11:50 – 12:15 pm. There is no morning recess again this year but students are given the time to have a snack in their classroom. Recess will be in the afternoon 1:15-1:30 pm.

#### Change in After School Routine

If there is a change in their regular after school routine, we require an email to the teacher and Jackie in the office or a phone call prior to noon. If we do not receive notification from you, your child will follow their regular routine.

## **Communication**

To save paper, as the year continues we will be sending most of our notices via email. ## **PSB Text Messaging System**

Parents are invited to join our emergency text messaging system. The system is configured to send text messages to mobile phone numbers whose recipients have agreed to receive them. We use text messages to communicate during emergency situations as well as specific school closures or early dismissals.

When a new number is added, you may see the following message: "PSB & CSLF messages. Reply Y to confirm, HELP 4 info. Msg&data rates may apply. Msg freq varies. schoolmessenger.com/smsca" Parents can easily opt-in by texting "Y" (or "Yes") to our Short Code number 978338 (Canadianbased numbers) or 61569 (US-based numbers).
